Winter MAP Scores

Grades 1-5 MAP scores will come home on **Friday, February 17th**. These scores give a good indication of how well your child is learning the prescribed curriculum. We are especially hopeful that you see growth in your child's scores from the Fall assessment to the Winter assessment. The students will take the assessment one more time in the Spring. Students tend to do better on this assessment if they spend the time reading the questions they are asked. Some students finish in record time and this usually does not bode well when their score is determined. Please emphasize that students should spend time on this assessment. This is the only way that both the school and you can get a true picture of how your child is doing over a previous assessment.

CogAT Home Reports

It is expected that Grade 5 CogAT scores will be mailed home on **February 23rd** with your student's placement letters.

It is expected that Gr. 3 CogAT scores will be mailed home on **March 6th**.

Winter conferences

Winter conferences will be held at LES on March 9th and 10th. Parents will be able to sign up for conferences using the online Synergy Conference Management system beginning on **Friday, February 17th at 9:00 a.m.** The system will close on Friday, March 3rd at 4:00 p.m. If you need to schedule or change a conference after March 3rd, you will need to call the office at 410-313-5506. **Directions for scheduling conferences were sent home yesterday with your child(ren).**

We recognize that many parents may want to conference with their child's Language Arts/Homeroom teachers but, in order to ensure that all parents have the opportunity to meet with their child's math teacher and to value the limited time that teachers have available, we appreciate your understanding in only scheduling a conference with your child's math teacher.

* Students in any grade may conduct a Science Investigation to answer a question/problem. Students will use *The Scientific Method* to learn the systematic approach to solving a problem.

** Students in Kindergarten, First or Second grade may submit a collection. Students will collect and organize something of interest, answering questions related to observations made while exploring their world.

*** Students in any grade may submit an invention. Students will use the engineering design process to create an invention that will solve a problem or answer a question.



It's Time to Register for Kindergarten

Registration for new students or students entering public school kindergarten in fall 2017 is currently being held in all Howard County public elementary schools at times determined by individual schools.

Kindergarten is mandatory in Maryland. State law requires that children entering kindergarten in the fall of 2017 must be 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2017. Children entering first grade in the fall of 2017 must be 6 years old on or before September 1, 2017. For details about registration and enrollment, visit www.hcpss.org/enroll/.

Parents or guardians are to register students at the school currently serving the address where the child's parent or guardian resides. Parents may check the School and Bus Locator link on the school system website, www.hcpss.org, or call the Public Information Office at 410-313-6600 for information on which school serves their neighborhood.

The parent or guardian must present the following information at the time of registration:

- The child's evidence of birth
- An authorized record of immunizations
- Proof of residency in the form of a lease, a deed and a utility bill
- Photo ID of the parent/guardian
- Proof of custody

Driver's licenses and voter registration cards will not be accepted as proof of residence. State law prohibits a child from attending school for even one day unless proof of immunization has been provided. Immunization and health forms are available at each elementary school.
