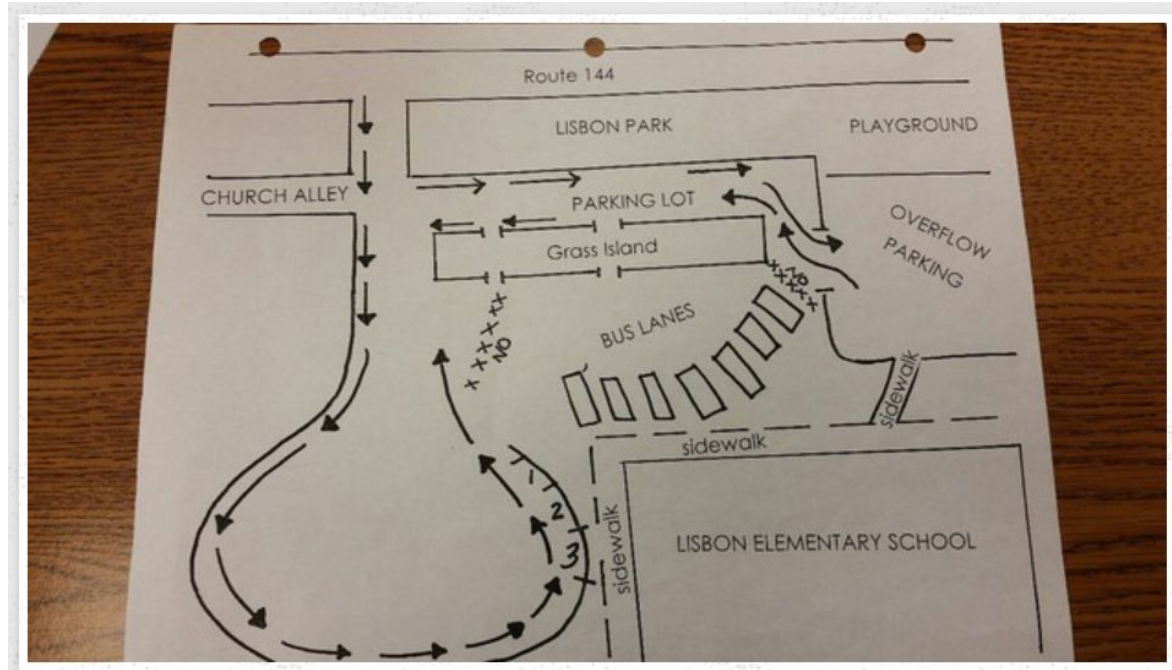

Utilizing contact information submitted through the Family File, parents and guardians automatically receive emails from HCPSS and our school.

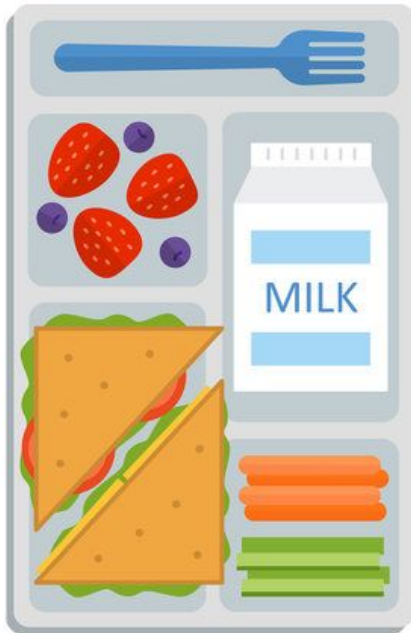

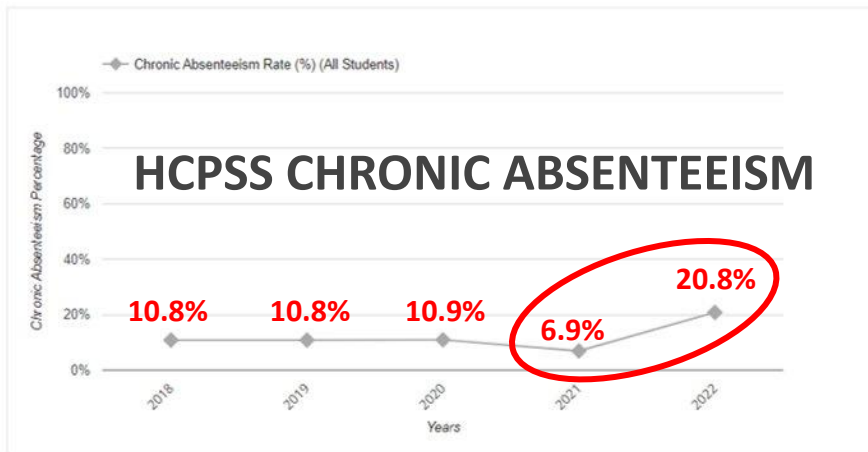


ATTENDANCE IS CRITICAL

HCPSS Attendance Expectations

Monitoring Attendance

- Student Support Team (SST) regularly monitors
 - Student attendance.
 - Trends and patterns

Early Interventions

- Call of Care and Concern from Classroom Teachers
- Parent Partnerships

Chronic Absenteeism

- Defined by COMAR: When a student is enrolled for at least 10 day and is absence on 10% or more school days.

HCPSS Attendance Expectations

Absences Reach 10%

- Parents will receive 1st attendance letter

Absences Reach 15%

- Parents will receive a 2nd attendance letter
- Possible conference to create an attendance plan

Absences Reach 20%

- Parents will receive a 3rd attendance letter
- Conference to implement an attendance contract with school administration

Habitually Truant (More than 20%)

- Referral to HCPSS Central Attendance Team
